## Enrollment Process

### All Applicants

Applications for enrollment at South Shore Charter Public School are welcome from all school-aged students who are residents of Massachusetts.

- Complete and sign the *K-11 Application Form*
- Submit a copy of the student's birth certificate *A student must be five years old (5) by October 31 of his or her kindergarten year*
- Read and sign the *Student/Parent Statement of Expectations*

### Applicants for Grades 7-11

- Submit a current transcript or most recent report card
- Write a letter explaining why you would like to attend SSCPS
- Complete and submit the *Resume Form*

### All Parents

The applicant's parent needs to write a letter to SSCPS including:

- The reasons you would like your child to attend SSCPS;
- Your thoughts on the learning style of your child to help us determine the most appropriate class placement;
- What skills and interests you, the parent, have that you would be willing to share with SSCPS.

### Decision Process

In any grade where there are more spaces than applicants, the applicant will be admitted without the Lottery. When there are more applicants than spaces in a grade an Enrollment Lottery is conducted. Those applicants not chosen in the Lottery will be placed on a Wait List in the order their name was chosen and contacted if openings occur at a later date. Those chosen will be contacted by letter. Each applicant accepted must respond with an *Intent to Attend Form* by March 5. If no *Intent to Attend* form is received by that date, their place in the class will be offered to the next applicant on the Wait List. Enrollment preference is given to siblings of current students and students living in our region. Once a student is accepted he or she will not have to reapply annually.

For applications to be considered for the 2010-2011 Enrollment Lottery, the application package must include all the items listed in the checklist above and received by the Enrollment Office no later than February 10, 2010.

Once accepted, each student and their family will be required to attend an official Enrollment Registration which may include Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Screening, ELL Screening, Learning Services Questionnaire, Diagnostic Assessment in English and Math for all new students entering grades 7-11. All 9<sup>th</sup> grade students and any new 10<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup> grade students are required to attend a mandatory Summer Institute and parents are required to attend a mandatory parent night in the spring.
